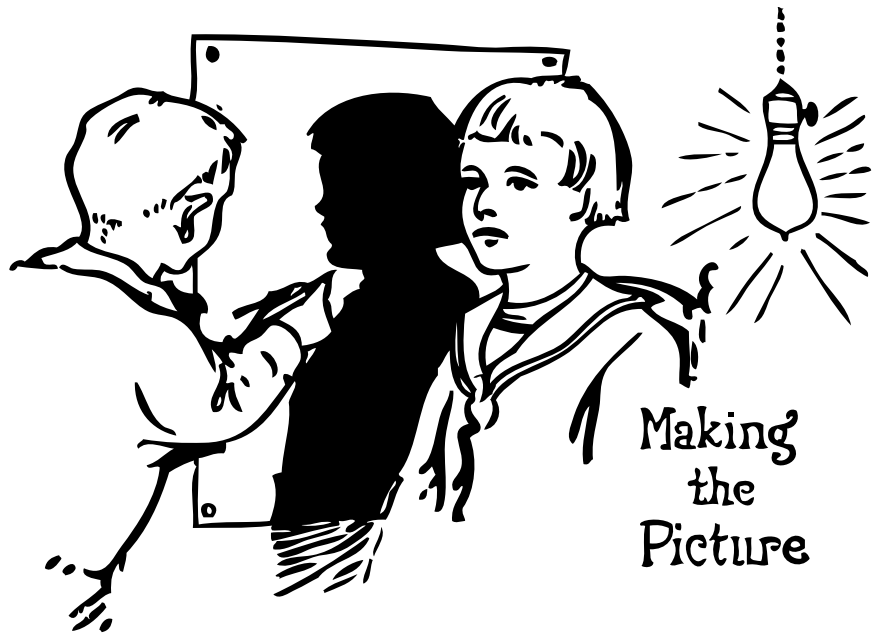
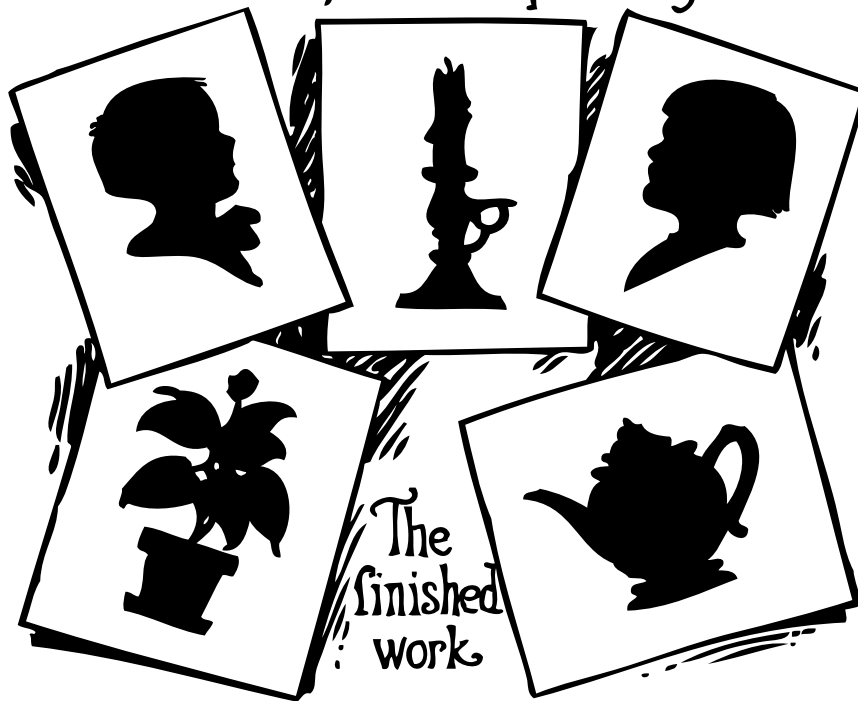


# Creating Silhouette Portraits

Here is a way you can make portraits of friends and pictures of familiar objects. . . . Fasten a sheet of paper on a flat wall. Seat your model in front of a good light so the shadow falls on the paper in profile. -- The model, of course, must be perfectly still while you carefully draw the

outline of the shadow. The paper should be dark or blackened on the back and when the shadow outline is carefully cut out and mounted on a lighter-colored paper the silhouette picture is finished.
